



## **ILPGA Commercial Mower Incentive Program Rules and Regulations**

**LIMIT: 3 APPLICATIONS PER COMPANY PER YEAR \$1,000.00 EACH (maximum of \$3,000.00) or Actual cost or up to \$750.00 FOR ELIGIBLE CONVERSIONS PER COMPANY PER YEAR (Maximum of \$3,000.00 per company per year)**

**Lawn Mower Sales Company can receive a \$250 rebate for the sale of propane lawn mowers (3 - \$250 rebates per customer / \$750 per customer per year)**

**This program is available for all marketers participating in the IPERC program.**

- The incentive program begins January 1, 2021 and ends when funds have been exhausted. Incentives available through ILPGA are subject to available funds.
- Applicants will be notified of the status of their applications within 30 days after the application is received at the ILPGA office. No applicant has a legal right or other entitlement to receive funding under the program or this agreement. A completed application does not bind ILPGA to approve or pay an incentive to any applicant.
- An applicant or propane marketer may be suspended from, or declared ineligible to participate in the program if the ILPGA determines that the applicant or propane marketer has submitted false information or otherwise violated program terms and conditions. Within 30 days after ILPGA suspends or declares an applicant or propane marketer ineligible, the applicant or propane marketer may appeal the action by submitting the appeal in writing to ILPGA. Actions taken by ILPGA with respect to the appeal will be final.
- An applicant or propane marketer who submits false information pertinent to a rebate is subject to criminal and civil penalties including U.S. Mail fraud. ILPGA will seek the return of any released funds as well as punitive damages for fraudulent applications or claims.
- Successful applicants will agree to participate in case studies and further documentation to promote propane mowers or educate others about the program.

**This program will only be offered as long as funds are available: the IPGA reserves the right to suspend the program at any time it determines funds are being exhausted.**
